VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT – TEAM MANAGERS POLICY 4

The North Mandurah Junior Football Club (NMJFC) recognizes that all parents should have the opportunity to be actively involved in their children's sport. The NMJFC encourages parents to develop their skills in a variety of roles.

The NMJFC will provide opportunities for all parents to be Team Manager by:

- Offering nominations for Team Manager Positions each year in all age groups
- Placing a two year maximum term on Team Manager positions (subject to parent interest and nomination)

The NMJFC will develop the skills of Team Managers by:

- Providing an information workshop pre-season, including an information pack
- Providing easy access to all relevant forms via the Club website
- Providing a support person from the committee

The NMJFC will expect their Team Managers to:

- Know the current Peel District Junior Competition by-laws
- Abide by the rules and by-laws
- To follow the NMJFC Code of Conduct
- Be positive role models for players, other volunteers, and to represent the Club in a positive manner at all times

Policy Review
